Who must Recycle: All residents and businesses of New Castle are required by state and local laws to recycle at their curb.

Materials Collected (residential only):

- Metal cans (including empty aerosol and paint cans with the lids removed)
- Plastic bottles & jugs
- Corrugated cardboard
- Magazines
- Newspapers, including inserts
- Mixed office paper and junk mail

Please note that only clean bottles, jugs, cans and paper products are recyclable in the curbside program. Do not include other items such as windows, toys, tubing, or any other item not listed above.

Businesses must recycle but may pick the recycling hauler of their choice.

How: At your curb. Materials can be mixed together.

When: Every other week. Consult the zone map you received from Aiken Refuse or download a copy from the Aiken Refuse website.

Spring/Fall Cleanup: No

Large/Bulky Item Pickup: Yes. Residents purchase special tags for bulky items through the City's contractor, Aiken Refuse. Tags are available for purchase from Aiken Refuse's website.

Leaves & Yard Waste (excluding grass): Yes. Leaf waste must be placed in a brown leaf bag and put out during your normal trash pickup. Contact the City or Aiken for the schedule.

Christmas Trees: Yes. Aiken will pick up Christmas Trees at no charge to their customer base between Jan 4 – Jan 14 on normal garbage days. The tree must be free of decorations and trees greater than 8' must be cut into 4 pieces.
